Summary:

Counsels children and parents individually and in groups regarding developmental, psychological and emotional problems. Counseling sessions can take place at school, home and or community setting.

Major Responsibilities:

1. Implementation of clinical services component of mental health services program;
2. Conduct individual, family, and group counseling services for client and collaterals;
3. Review and approve Individual Services Plan for each client
4. Participate in community education and networking activities;
5. Participate in training and in-service activities with staff;
6. Participate in weekly staff and case review planning meetings;
7. Provide clinical supervision

Perform other duties as deemed necessary for fulfillment of program requirements.
